Women Artists in the Age of Impressionism

This groundbreaking exhibition broadly surveys a key chapter in art history in which an international group of female artists overcame gender-based restrictions to make remarkable creative strides. Featuring more than eighty paintings by thirty-seven artists from thirteen countries, drawn from prominent collections across the United States and abroad, this exhibition presents renowned artists such as Berthe Morisot (French), Mary Cassatt (American), and Rosa Bonheur (French) alongside lesser-known yet equally important peers including Anna Ancher (Danish), Lilla Cabot Perry (American), and Paula Modersohn-Becker (German).

Thoroughly Modern: Women in 20th Century Art and Design

The advent of modernism was a game-changer that upended traditional notions of art and design. Featuring work from the Speed and from private collections, this exhibition celebrates the women whose work influenced both the visual arts and new ways of living.
