CHICAGO ARCHITECTURE CENTER & CRUISE

The Chicago Architecture Center (CAC) was founded in 1966 as the Chicago Architecture Foundation to save the historic Glessner House. Since then, the CAC has grown to become one of the largest cultural organizations in Chicago. For more than 50 years, their educators, 450 volunteer docents, and 150 guest services volunteers have shared the stories of Chicago architecture with millions of Chicagoans and visitors.

In their newest location on Wacker Drive, they continue to inspire their guests to discover why design matters. On view in the gallery is a 4,250-building scale model of Chicago, and we will be able to visit their award-winning gift store before boarding for a 90-minute cruise. The CAC River Cruise has been named "top tour in Chicago and one of the top ten tours in the U.S." according to TripAdvisor. Docents will interpret more than 50 buildings along the Chicago River, and we will find out how Chicago grew from a small settlement into one of the world's largest cities in less than 100 years.
