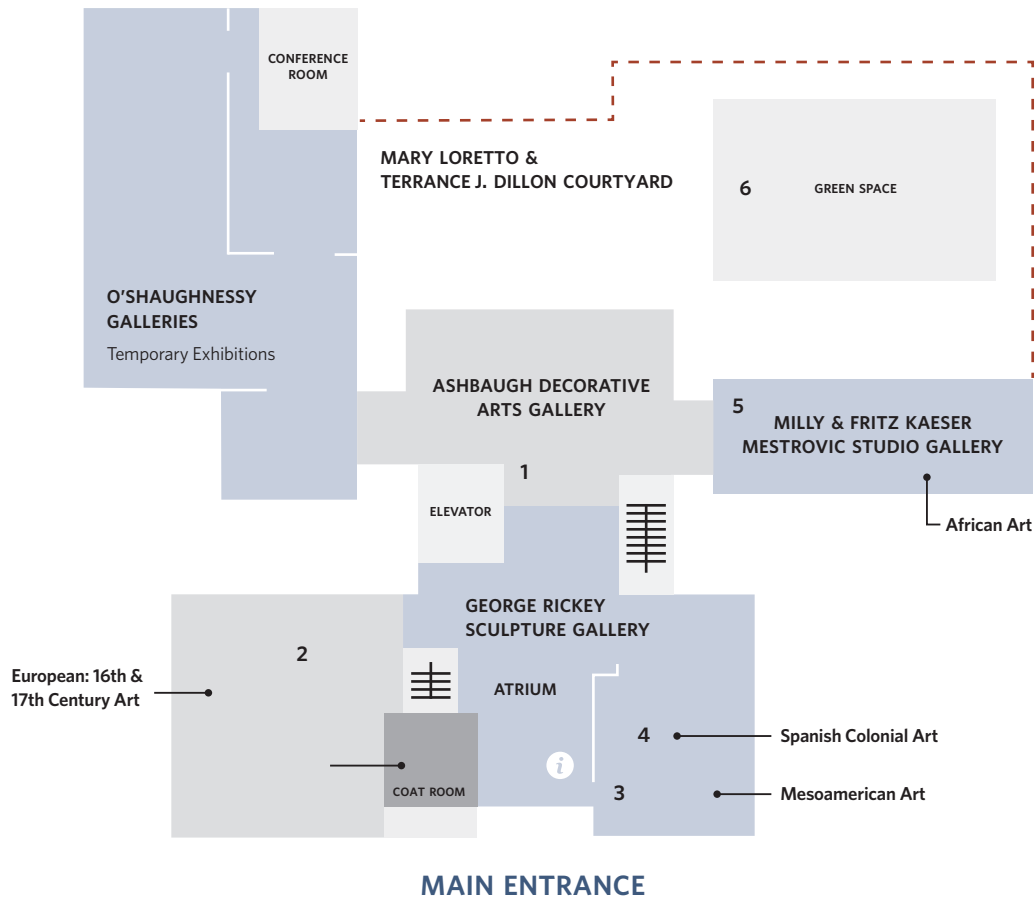

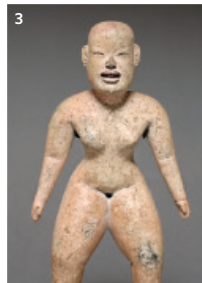

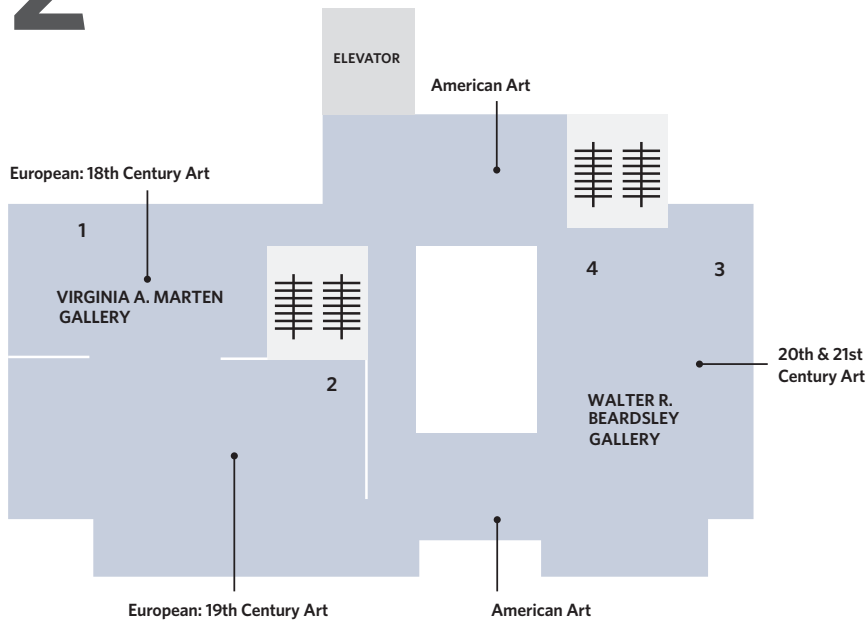

SCULPTURE PARK

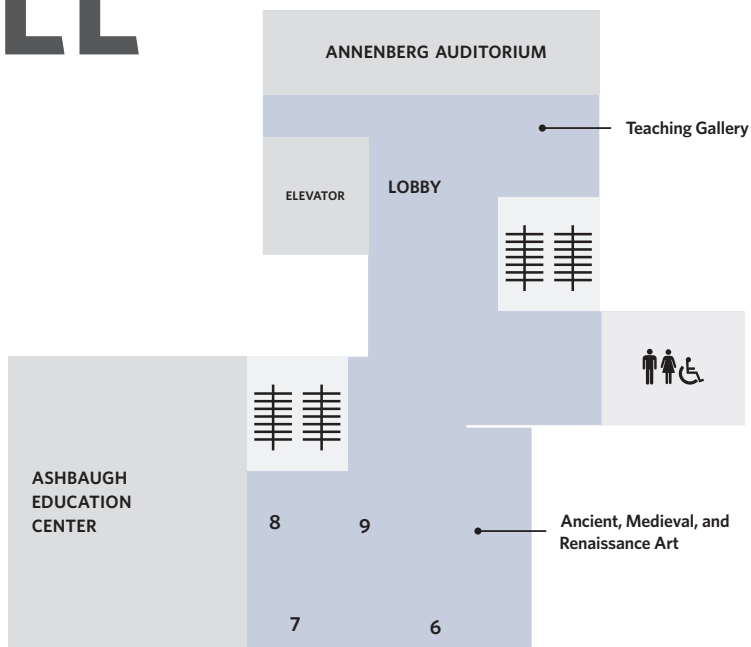
Charles B. Hayes Family Sculpture Park

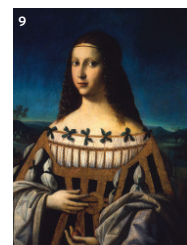
